Authors must include a completed checklist when submitting their narrative review manuscripts (initial submission). All items in the checklist are required unless marked "optional."

When drafting the manuscripts in Microsoft Word, authors should refer to the Information for Authors, which includes a downloadable Word template, on the <u>ARCR</u> website.
